Free Eye Check-up Camp at NIPUN Basti Vikas Kendra

The Free Eye Check-up Camp, held on March 17th, 2024, at NIPUN Basti Vikas Kendra, J.J. Cluster, Bengali Camp, New Delhi, in collaboration with the Centre for Sight, was a resounding success. The camp, designed to identify individuals with weak eyesight, consisted of three stages of screening. Senior citizens, differently-abled individuals, orphans, women, and children in need of vision correction were provided with customized spectacles tailored to their specific requirements.



A total of 106 beneficiaries participated, undergoing comprehensive screening for various eye ailments. Ten individuals were referred for further examination regarding cataract operations. Throughout the camp, individual counseling sessions were held to raise awareness about eye disorders, the significance of early detection, and the identification of refractive errors and eye ailments among underprivileged individuals. The Eye Check-up Camp proved highly beneficial, offering valuable insights into eye health for many participants. NIPUN's timely intervention helped enhance their focus and productivity, while also preventing further deterioration of eyesight among senior citizens. 
Education Beyond the Classroom
