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HIV/VDRL Testing Camp and Awareness Event in Batala, Gurdaspur

NIPUN is implementing a Targeted Intervention project in Batala, Gurdaspur, Punjab, where we provide services to hundreds of High-Risk Group (HRG) individuals who are registered with us. With the support of the Punjab State AIDS Control Society and NACO, NIPUN offers various services related to health, HIV/AIDS, and overall well-being, aiming to empower HRGs in Batala, Gurdaspur.

On 30th August 2024, an awareness and HIV/VDRL testing camp was organized at the targeted location in Batala, Gurdaspur, Punjab.

A street play was also performed to spread awareness about HIV/AIDS. The event was organized by the Punjab State AIDS Control Society and NACO.



Empowering Transgender Community Through Self Help Groups

NIPUN organized a meeting for the Self-Help Group (SHG) "Pahal," formed by members of the Transgender Community in Kapashera. This initiative supports NIPUN's mission to empower marginalized communities through economic and social support.

In collaboration with the Delhi State AIDS Control Society and NACO, NIPUN is implementing a Targeted Intervention project for the Transgender community in Kapashera and surrounding areas in South West Delhi. The project addresses key challenges such as healthcare access, social stigma, and economic vulnerability.

During the meeting, the importance of savings and the SHG concept was discussed. SHGs are vital for financial stability and self-reliance, especially for marginalized communities. "Pahal" marks a significant step towards the financial independence and empowerment of the Transgender Community in Kapashera. NIPUN remains dedicated to supporting "Pahal" and similar initiatives that promote the development and empowerment of vulnerable groups.

Youngsters Sensitized on Poshak Aahar (Nutritious Food)

NIPUN-UMANG Vocational Training Centre organized an awareness session on Poshak Aahar (Nutrition) on September 8th, 2024, in the West District of Delhi to educate youngsters about the importance of healthy eating habits and proper nutrition for maintaining a healthy lifestyle.

During the event, trainees from the vocational training centres were sensitized through exhibitions, discussions, slogan writing, and practical sessions on proper diets, the benefits of eating healthy foods, the importance of green vegetables, and the basics of preparing nutritious meals.

The initiative aims to reduce malnutrition among the youth residing in slum communities and resettlement sites, where NIPUN operates vocational training centres, with a special focus on young girls.



Career Counselling and Skill Training

Sarvodaya Kanya Vidyalaya, Peeragadi, West Delhi invited NIPUN-UMANG Vocational Training Centre to conduct a career counseling and skill training program for their Senior Secondary graduates, aimed at enhancing livelihood opportunities.

On behalf of NIPUN-UMANG Vocational Training Centre, Ms. Jyoti, Assistant Project Coordinator, gave a presentation on various training courses, employment engagement programs, exposure visits, and job placement opportunities. Overall, the discussion with the students and the Sarvodaya Kanya Vidyalaya team was very productive.

Workshop with Mothers

In collaboration with Mahaveer International and Container Corporation of India Ltd (Concor), NIPUN organized a workshop for expecting and lactating mothers on 13th September 2024 at NIPUN-Swagat Kendra, South West District.

Ms. Anju Sharma and her team provided valuable information to the participants through discussions and video presentations.



They emphasized the importance of eating more during pregnancy, consuming whole grains, sprouted grams, and fermented foods, taking adequate amounts of milk, meat, or eggs, eating plenty of vegetables and fruits, avoiding superstitions and food taboos, and regularly taking iron, folate, and calcium supplements after 14-16 weeks of pregnancy and continuing through lactation. Goody bags containing baby kits, sanitary napkins, kala chana, groundnuts, and sattu packets were distributed to all 32 participants.

Balanced Nutrition Along with Education

One of NIPUN's primary objectives is to ensure that every child not only receives quality education but also the right amount of nutrition through a balanced diet, made possible by its Nutrition Supplement program. Both education and health are vital for the holistic development of a child. However, it has been observed that many children from families of daily wage earners, construction workers, and those living in slums or at construction sites suffer from malnutrition due to a lack of proper care and adequate food. Many of these children come to school without having breakfast.

To combat this, NIPUN provides daily supplementary nutrition to address malnutrition and raises awareness among parents and communities in slum areas and construction sites about healthy childcare practices and affordable nutritious meals for their children. Special diets such as eggs, bananas, and cereal mixtures are given daily to malnourished children.

Through this program, hundreds of non-formal learners, particularly girls aged from birth to 14 years in the Delhi/NCR region, are benefiting. Most of these children are enrolled in NIPUN's Creches, Balwadi, Non-Formal, and Remedial Education centres

NIPUN's Siksha Saheli, South East project, organized a discussion on the nutritional needs of children, adolescent girls, women, senior citizens, and issues related to malnutrition. During the session, supplementary nutrition materials were demonstrated, and their importance was explained to all the attendees. Before concluding the program, the resource person addressed and answered all the participants' questions.



Ab Ham Sakshar Hain – Now We Are <mark>Literate</mark>

The primary objective of NIPUN is to empower communities, especially first-generation learners and women from socially and economically disadvantaged backgrounds. NIPUN regularly organizes legal, financial, health literacy, and adult education programs for daily wage earners, laborers, and construction workers across Delhi NCR. On International Literacy Day 2024, NIPUN provided educational opportunities to adults who missed formal schooling and now seek to learn. These options include literacy, basic education, skill development (vocational training), and continuing education. As part of this initiative, NIPUN launched the campaign "Ab Ham Sakshar Hai – Now We Are Literate." According to Ms. Zareena Khatoon, "I can now read newspapers, write, and calculate our income and expenses." The empowered women proudly displayed their signatures on a community wall.

These interventions have not only provided skills but also instilled confidence, enabling women to pursue economic independence and shape a brighter future for themselves and their families.
